- 1. Financing Resilience Infrastructure Project Update (FRIP)
  - Reviewed details around this new project, including project objectives, project outputs, timelines, and next steps.
  - We were selected as 1 of 13 municipalities across Canada to be invited to be a project participant.
  - We outlined 16 highlighted projects. These were prioritized by The Cooperators and 6 remain on the list. Prioritized ranking as 1 or 2.
- 2. Emergency Social Services Exercise
  - Reviewed the Emergency Social Services Functional Exercise that was held on August 23, 2023

- Highlighted the activities that took place during this workshop as well as the main take aways and areas for improvement.
- This exercise involved the review of both the Extreme Heat Emergency Response Plan and the Emergency Social Services Plan. This workshop also involved the opening of a mock ECC and Reception Centre.

## 3. UBC/UofA Research Project

- Strategic Infrastructure Planning: Wildfire Evacuation, Transportation and Human Behavior, supported by infrastructure Canada through a research and knowledge initiative to gain and advance the understanding of public infrastructure needs and opportunities relevant to Canadians.
- Canmore was 1 of 5 towns in Alberta and BC that were selected for this study.
- Reviewed why Canmore was selected, desired outcomes of this project, how these results can be used and potential implementation into our evacuation plans.

#### 4. Evacuation Workshop

• Reviewed the key successes and key learnings of the August 29, 2023 workshop. Purpose of this workshop was to provide shared understanding of what resources are available in Canmore, how to activate these resources and where the resources need to be deployed and why in multiple evacuation scenarios. This also provided the opportunity to make recommendations for improvement to our current plan.
