DETAILS OF ADDENDUM:

1. Is there any permit fee that we need to pay to Town of Canmore, to do the work after we submit our traffic management plan?

No permit fee will be required as part of the Road Use Permit and your associated traffic or pedestrian management plan. For more detailed information on these permit requirements please see the downloadable Road Use Permit Application available at: https://www.canmore.ca/public/download/files/231507.

2. The timber specification attached mentions that final scope will be confirmed only after coating work on test areas 1, 2 and 3 is performed. Do you want us to initially carry the material only to perform the test area scope or estimate the total we might need for recoating. Obviously, we will not be fully recoating the bridge and only coat the exposed timber elements (except the decking board). Please let us know what you would want us to allow for the material. I can mention the material that was allowed in the quote, and this can be reviewed upon confirmation of final scope. For labor at this time we will assume we will need 1 coat of Cetol 1 and 2 coats of Cetol 23 for exposed timber elements. On the underside we will be only coating the floor beams and abutments visible to naked eye.

In your pricing for BG-31, please do provide a quotation that includes an estimated total material required for re-coating, not only for the compatibility tests.

3. Can you please provide some clarity of disposal of existing coating once it is removed. Is there a disposal center within the town of Canmore? So we can reach out to them to get some information on what we need to dispose of the existing coatings after they are sanded off.

For disposal, the nearest location is the Francis Cooke Regional Resource Recovery Centre & Class III Landfill which is located approximately 20 minutes east of Canmore. For more details on this site and what they accept for disposal please see here: https://bvwaste.ca/facility-guide/.
